ICSF WORLD CUP TOUR 2018

To all member federations of the International Casting Sport Federation ICSF

During 2017 you have read about our good intentions that we have to improve, to modernize and to change parts of the structure of the World Cup Tournaments. We and many of you took part at World Championships 2017 in Szamotuly/Poland. Many good ideas were discussed there.

Now, we would like to introduce the World-Cup-Tournaments (WCT) 2018 and their rules.

The Executive Board has newly decided in favour of maximum 6 competitions as World-Cup-Tournaments 2018.

In order to improve the attraction of the final and to have as many participants as possible and that there will be equality of opportunity for all, the points of ranking will be double. This year, the best four rankings will be evaluated. All participants on the list of the WCT 2018 will be rated.

Rules of organization of one of the ICSF – WCT - in 2018.

- The WCT's are organized for ladies and men. Juniors and veterans are allowed to participate, but they will be evaluated in the ladies or men division.
 New the best 3 juniors will be awarded additionally.
- 2. All WCT in the season of 2018 are organized for single casters in combination of events 1 to 5.
- 3. All the WCT will be organized following the International Tournament Rules ICW 2016 of ICSF.
- 4. The rating is based on ranking and points (see below).
- 5. The 4 best ranking of maximum 6 Tournament are evaluated for the allover winner of the World Cup 2018.
- 6. At the last WCT in Sostanj / Slovenia, the final of the WCT, the ranking points will be the double see below).
- 7. The WCT with the events 1 to 5 should be carried out on one day.
- 8. The organizer must offer the plugs for the distance event no. 5. All the plugs must be marked with the starting number.
- 9. For the winners 2018 ICSF will present 3 cups each for the ladies and the men.
- 10. In 2018, ICSF will award three ladies and five men.
- 11. The starting fee for each WCT 2018 cannot exceed 45, € per athlete, of which the charge of 10, € per athlete who are named on the official result list of the WCT has to be transferred to the ICSF Official on the tournament day. All this money will be distributed completely to the winners.

- 12. The price money for women and men is different and will be calculated on the base of the number of the participating ladies and men.
- 13. 13. This money will be distributed at the World Cup Final in Sostanj / Slovenia to the overall winners and goes to three ladies and five men.
- 14. 14.All casting sport federation organized in the ICSF will receive invitations for participation and all their athletes should be allowed to participate.
- 15. The invitation should give the opportunity to the participants to organize accommodations and food at their own costs.
- 16. At least one recognized international judge from another country must be invited and be present at the competition. The costs are for the organizer.
- 17. A jury must be nominated. The jury must have three members, one of them from the organizing body.
- 18. For the evaluation a digital program has to be used. After the competition the result list must be given or sent out to the ICSF.
- 19. The same day a pleasant get-together with a diner or a banquet should be the closing of the competition. This is the occasion for the price giving ceremony. Every participating federation has to receive an official result list. The festive evening should be payed by the participants themselves or be sponsored.
- 20. The whole prize giving ceremony will be held by representatives of the ICSF and the organizer
