WHEN:

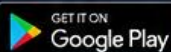
- STARTS: 1 AUGUST 2026
- ENDS: 31 JANUARY 2027

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- Youth in two categories:
 - Juniors: 10 years to 16 years
 - Seniors: 17 years to 22 years
- Girls and boys  

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- Download the **Keepnet Way Bay Fishing App** for the App Stores.
- Register for 6 months subscription.
- Pay the registration fee.
- Go online to <https://www.keepnet.co/competition/dashboard/2349/cips-world-youth-fishing-competition/about>
- Select your age group
- Register for the competition
- Start fishing



HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CATCH:

- Once you have caught your fish and its landed.
- Take your cell phone, open the **Keepnet Way Bay Fishing App** and get it ready to record the video.
- Place the fish on the measure tape.
- On the **Keepnet App**, select **add fish** and start recording the video on the cell phone of the measurement.
- The fish catches must be **measured in centimeter** on a measuring tape from the tip of the mouth to the point of the tail.



MEASURE CORRECTLY – FROM THE TIP OF THE MOUTH TO THE POINT OF THE TAIL (IN CENTIMETER)

- Once the measurement is done, keep recording and **release** the fish back in the water while recording.
- Stop recording 
- Enter the **species** and length of the fish caught and submit 
- Continue fishing until the next catch

FISH SPECIES:

The qualifying fish species are from
Freshwater Species and Saltwater Species.

FRESHWATER SPECIES

- Trout (Salmon species)
- Grayling
- Black Bass
- Peacock Bass
- Carp
- Bream
- Zander
- Pike
- Tilapia

SALTWATER SPECIES

- Salmon
- Wahoo
- Skipjack tuna
- Mullet
- Mackrell
- Trevally
- Dorado

IMPORTANT RULES:

FISHING TACKLE:

Only commercially sold fishing tackle, be it fishing rods, reels, and lines, may be used to catch the fish. Drones may not be used during fishing activities.



LOCATION:

Participants may catch the fish species at any angling venue and country.



QUALIFYING CATCH:

A video recording must be made of the fish measurement and the successful release of the fish back into the water. The measurement must be clearly visible on the measuring tape.



BAG LIMIT:

Each angler may register a maximum of 5 fish in the different fish species.



CATCH AND RELEASE:

All catches must be successfully released on the video recording.



DISPLAYING OF CLASSIFICATION:

The top 10 longest fish species will be displayed on the Keepnet Application per age group and gender category.
